**Proverbs 9:1-12 New International Version (NIV)**

**Invitations of Wisdom and Folly**

**9** Wisdom has built her house;  
she has set up[a] its seven pillars.

**2** She has prepared her meat and mixed her wine;

she has also set her table.

**3** She has sent out her servants, and she calls  
from the highest point of the city,

**4** "Let all who are simple come to my house!"

To those who have no sense she says,

**5** "Come, eat my food  
and drink the wine I have mixed.

**6** Leave your simple ways and you will live;  
walk in the way of insight."

**7** Whoever corrects a mocker invites insults;  
whoever rebukes the wicked incurs abuse.

**8** Do not rebuke mockers or they will hate you;  
rebuke the wise and they will love you.

**9** Instruct the wise and they will be wiser still;  
teach the righteous and they will add to their learning.

**10** The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom,  
and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

**11** For through wisdom your days will be many,  
and years will be added to your life.

**12** If you are wise, your wisdom will reward you;  
if you are a mocker, you alone will suffer.

**13** Folly is an unruly woman;  
she is simple and knows nothing.

**14** She sits at the door of her house,  
on a seat at the highest point of the city,

**15** calling out to those who pass by,  
who go straight on their way,

**16** "Let all who are simple come to my house!"  
To those who have no sense she says,

**17** "Stolen water is sweet;  
food eaten in secret is delicious!"

**18** But little do they know that the dead are there,  
that her guests are deep in the realm of the dead.

## **Matthew 4:1-11 New International Version (NIV)**

### **Jesus Is Tested in the Wilderness**

**4** Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. **2** After fasting forty days and forty nights, he was hungry. **3** The tempter came to him and said, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread."

**4** Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"

**5** Then the devil took him to the holy city and had him stand on the highest point of the temple. **6** "If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down. For it is written:

"He will command his angels concerning you,  
and they will lift you up in their hands,  
so that you will not strike your foot against a stone."

**7** Jesus answered him, "It is also written: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.'"

**8** Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor. **9** "All this I will give you," he said, "if you will bow down and worship me."

**10** Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.'"

**11** Then the devil left him, and angels came and attended him.
